



The **Google Safety Engineering Centre** (<u>GSEC</u>) officially opened in November 2023. This center will play a key role in shaping the future of cybersecurity in Europe & around the world as it will serve as a catalyst for public-private-partnerships, fostering cutting-edge research & development. The recent agreement between the University of Malaga & Google will ensure that Malaga continues to educate cybersecurity professionals who can safeguard our digital future.

Google Safety Engineering Center

The Andalusian Cybersecurity Center opened its doors in the Malaga Port in November 2023. With a \notin 74 million investment, the center will play a crucial role in the Andalusian Cybersecurity Strategy 2022-2025, overseeing essential services for public institutions and critical infrastructures. It will also promote awareness campaigns, training, and incentives for businesses to incorporate cybersecurity practices, fostering a secure digital ecosystem.

Interuniversity Microelectronics Centre (imec) - Founded in 1984, a world-leading technology centre in the research, design and manufacture of semiconductors and microelectronics prototypes.

The **Spanish Prime Minister** announced in mid-October 2024 during his visit to the imec headquarters that: "the first **100 million euros** had been allocated for the design and implementation of the scientific infrastructure operated by IMEC" in Málaga. This Andalusian city has positioned itself in recent years as the Spanish Hub of reference in the fields of technology, analytics and artificial intelligence."





Spanish National Incentives



• In order to provide legal certainty regarding the activities of R&D that may grant companies the right to tax credits, companies can apply for a Technical Report to the Ministry of Science and Innovation or to CDTI, the Centre for the Technological and Industrial Development.

R&D INCENTIVES INVESTMENTS (excluding buildings or land)	25% of total expenditure in R&D incurred in the tax year

- **40% discount in Social Security contributions** for common contingencies to all research staff that work exclusively on R&D.
- In addition, the Spanish Corporate Income Tax law introduces a **patent box** type of incentive. This can be up to **60% of the tax base reduction** applicable to income from the assignment of the right to use or exploit certain intangibles.
- Employees arriving from outside of Spain will benefit from a special taxation measure that allows them a fixed rate of personal income tax for **the first 6 years of 24 % on all income** up to 600,000 € assuming they have not lived in Spain during the prior ten fiscal periods.
- Andalucía is one of the few European regions classified as Class I; therefore Málaga can receive the **MAXIMUM % of incentives from the European Union**.

Municipal Rebates



Fiscal rebates from the City of Malaga that could be applicable to a company if the circumstance foreseen in the ordinance are met.

Real Estate Tax (Impuesto sobre Bienes Inmuebles – IBI)	A rebate of up to 50% of the full amount of the tax for real estate in which systems for the thermal or electrical use of energy from the sun have been installed.	15%
Economic Activities Tax (Impuesto sobre Actividades Económicas - IAE)	Allowance for job creation of up to 50% of the corresponding quota, for taxpayers who pay the municipal quota and who have increased the average number of workers with permanent contracts during the tax period immediately prior to the application of the allowance, in relation to the period prior to that.	3% (increase <5%) 7% (increase 5-10%) 15% (increase 10-14%) 25% (Increase 14-60%) 45% (Increase >60%)
	Up to 50% of the corresponding tax liability for taxpayers who pay municipal taxes and who use or produce energy from renewable energy facilities or cogeneration systems.	10% of the actual cost (limit 50% of the tax liability).
	A rebate of up to 50% of the corresponding quota for taxpayers who pay the municipal quota and who carry out their industrial activities, from the beginning of their activity or by subsequent relocation, in premises or installations far from the most populated areas of the municipality.	25%
	A rebate of up to 50% of the corresponding quota for taxpayers who pay municipal taxes and who establish a transportation plan for their workers aimed at reducing energy consumption and emissions caused by commuting to the workplace and promoting the use of the most efficient means of transport, such as collective or shared transport.	30% (15-30% benefited) 40% (30-50% benefited) 50% (>50% benefited)

Municipal Rebates



Tax	Description	Rebate
Constructions, Installations and Works Tax (Impuesto sobre Construcciones, Instalaciones y Obras - ICIO)	Rebate of up to 95% in favor of the constructions, facilities or works that are declared of special interest or municipal utility for concurring social, cultural, historical-artistic circumstances or of promotion of the employment that justify such declaration	75% of activities located in industrial zones that have the urban qualification of productive or logistic land in industrial estates.
		Employment promotion: 20% (staff increase >20% and more than 3 workers).
		50% Non-governmental organizations (95% if they are for assistance, education or social integration).
		The application of this rebate will depend on the legal configuration of the participants in the project.
		95% for vehicle parking works
	Rebate of up to 95% in favor of the constructions, facilities or works in which systems for the thermal or electrical use of solar energy are incorporated.	95%

- Not all rebates could be applicable simultaneously, or would otherwise be limited in amount.
- Some may not be applicable depending on the wording of the standard and its compatibility with the project.
